

PLANTING RIPARIAN SPECIES IS THE BEST, CHEAPEST AND EASIEST WAY TO REDUCE FLOODING ON YOUR PROPERTY.



Benefits of planting:

- 1. Vegetation absorbs and stores excess water from rain events
- 2. Erosion control and stream bank stabilization
- 3. Disrupts and reduces water flow speed and intensity
- 4. Lessens downstream flooding
- 5. Plus, there are many ecological benefits!

TREES FOR TRIBS

Trees for Tribs is a program run by the NYS DEC, which provides native plant species to be planted in flooding zones to reduce flooding risk.

Anyone who owns property in NY within 50 feet of a waterbody is eligible for **free seedlings.**
